

# Win a Share in a Horse Promotion

## Terms and Conditions

### February 2026

1. All Entrants (Entrants) who participate in this Harness Racing New Zealand (HRNZ) 'Win a share in a Horse' promotion (the Promotion) are deemed to accept these terms and conditions (the T's & Cs) of entry. Any entries in this Promotion that do not comply with these terms and conditions will be deemed invalid and HRNZ takes no responsibility for such entries.
2. The Ts & Cs may change from time to time, at HRNZ's discretion

#### **Entry**

3. The Promotion entry period will commence at 9.00 am January 19, 2026, and close at 5.00pm February 18, 2026 (the Promotion Period). Entries are to be made via electronic means either direct or use of a QR code on a racecourse during the Promotion Period.
4. An Entrant may submit one (1) entry to the Promotion.
5. For an Entry to be valid, an Entrant's submitted name must not be a duplicate of an earlier entry or a pseudonym of the person who submitted an earlier entry.
6. Entry is open to all harness fans resident in New Zealand, eighteen years old and over, of New Zealand's most exciting racing code - harness racing.
7. HRNZ staff, Board Members, contractors and their Immediate Families are not eligible to enter this Promotion. For avoidance of doubt, 'Immediate Families' include spouses, grandparents, parents, children, and grandchildren, whether by marriage, past marriages, remarriage, adoption, co-habitation or other family extension.
8. Any person who is prohibited under the New Zealand Rules of Racing from owning a standardbred Horse is not eligible to enter the Promotion.
9. HRNZ may, in its absolute discretion and without being required to provide a specific reason, refuse to accept any entry.

#### **Winning the Prize**

10. The Winner will be selected by HRNZ on Thursday, February 19 2026. HRNZ's determination of the Winner will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into. In particular, HRNZ reserves the right to refuse to award the Prize to an entrant who HRNZ decides (in its absolute discretion) has violated these Ts & Cs, gained unfair advantage in participating in the Promotion or won using fraudulent means.

11. The Winner will be notified by email. Where HRNZ's attempts to contact the Winner fail (e.g. when the Winner cannot be contacted by email after three attempts) HRNZ may select another Winner in such manner as HRNZ thinks fit.
12. The Winner must claim the Prize in person. In claiming the Prize the Winner accepts all these Ts & Cs.
13. If the Prize (or any part of the Prize) is unavailable for any reason, HRNZ, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to substitute the Prize (or part of the Prize) with a prize to the equal monetary value. The Prize, or any unused portion of the Prize, cannot be exchanged for cash or other products or services, or otherwise transferred or modified.
14. All costs not included in the Prize are the sole responsibility of the Winner. HRNZ takes no responsibility if the Prize Winner is unable to use the Prize for any reason whatsoever.
15. The Winner takes the Prize entirely at their own risk and indemnifies HRNZ for any claim for any accident, injury, property damage or loss of life that may occur in connection with the Prize.
16. The Winner is responsible for all insurance, tax or other costs that may be associated with the Prize, except as specifically provided otherwise for in these Ts and Cs.

### **The Prize**

17. The Prize comprises:
  - A. A credit of \$5,000 plus GST to buy a share in a Next Gen eligible standardbred Horse (Horse).
  - B. HRNZ will place the Winner into an ownership group of a Horse purchased at the New Zealand Bloodstock Standardbred Yearling Sales. The choice of the Horse and trainer will be at the sole discretion of HRNZ. HRNZ may consult the Winner on the proposed Horse and trainer selection but is under no obligation to do so.
  - C. Subject to sub-clause D below, the \$5,000 credit, is the total amount inclusive of all direct and indirect costs for the purchase of the Horse and a trainer taking possession of it.
  - D. For a period of 24 months starting in the month after the sale HRNZ will pay the Winner, on invoice from the Trainer or Syndicate Manager, up to \$400 per month, to cover training fees and other ownership costs of the Horse. The maximum sum payable to the Winner under this sub-clause is \$7,200 in the 24 month period.
  - E. The Winner will be liable for any additional costs over and above \$400 per month (including, for the avoidance of doubt, any veterinary costs).
  - F. The Winner will not be entitled access to the Horse at any time, except as allowed by the Trainer or Manager at their complete discretion.
  - G. If the Horse is sold before 24 months has elapsed from the month of purchase (at the absolute discretion of the Authorised Manager), the Winner will receive the net proceeds of sale based on the percentage share of the Horse they own,

less the value of the prize (\$5,000) and any other costs or charges associated with sale.

- H. At the end of the 24-month period or when the Prize's month contribution is spent, the Winner has the option to either continue ownership of the Horse (and will be liable for its share of training fees and all other costs and charges that may result) or sell their share.
- I. If the Winner wishes to sell their share, the Trainer/Syndicate Manager will offer the share to the other owners of the Horse (with value determined by market demand). The Winner will be liable for its share of training fees and other costs and charges that may result until the share is sold.
- J. If the other owners of the Horse do not buy the Winner's share the Winner may sell their share in the Horse to a third party.
- K. If the Winner chooses to sell their share, the value of the prize (\$5,000) and any other costs or charges associated with sale will be deducted from the sale price.
- L. The Winner will continue to be liable for any additional costs and charges (above the \$400 monthly Promoter contribution) until the share is sold.
- M. No compensation will be paid by HRNZ should the sale price be lower than the purchased price. HRNZ is not liable for any loss of potential prize-winnings, earnings or otherwise if the Horse is unable to race due to injury, illness or death.
- N. HRNZ does not provide any warranty or accept any liability in relation to the quality or performance of the Horse, including the number of races the Horse will compete in, the value of prize-winnings the Horse will win or the value of any prize.
- O. Any decision regarding the health of the Horse or the entry of the Horse into any race will be at the absolute discretion of the Trainer/Syndicate Manager of the Horse or the relevant racing authority.
- P. Independent financial advice is recommended to be sought as tax implications may arise because of accepting the Prize.
- Q. The Winners must sign a legal release, in a form acceptable to HRNZ in its absolute discretion, if requested by HRNZ.

### **Other conditions**

- 18. The Winner agrees to be involved in any reasonable promotional activities, stipulated by HRNZ (without compensation), including but not limited to photographs, the publication of the Winner's name, and any images. HRNZ will own the copyright in any such images and photograph(s) and in all material incorporating the photograph(s) or film.
- 19. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, HRNZ and any person in connection with this Promotion are not liable for any direct, indirect, special or consequential loss or damage whatsoever suffered or personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with: (a) Registration for or participation in this Promotion; (b) The use (or non-use) of the Prize; and (c) The administration of this Promotion.

20. Failure by HRNZ to enforce any of its rights under these terms and conditions at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
21. Any personal information provided by an Entrant in participating in this Promotion will be held in accordance with the Privacy Act 2020. The information collected and held by HRNZ about you may be used by HRNZ from time to time to: (a) Administer this Promotion and verify compliance with these terms and conditions; (b) Ensure fairness and the integrity of this Promotion; (c) Provide you with notifications, reminders and offers; (d) Carry out general market research relating to harness racing; (e) To invite you to participate in surveys, sweepstakes, Promotions and similar promotions.
22. Pursuant to the Privacy Act 2020, you have the right to view the personal information you have provided when entering this Promotion. You may also request to review and correct any of that personal information by contacting HRNZ. Additional rights may apply under applicable law.
23. By entering this Promotion, an Entrant agrees to receive marketing and promotional material from HRNZ (including electronic material).
24. HRNZ reserves the right to amend, vary, extend, or discontinue the Promotion and the Ts & Cs at any stage, for any reason.
25. HRNZ takes no responsibility for any inability to enter, complete, continue or conclude the Promotion due to equipment or technical malfunction, Force Majeure or otherwise.
26. To the fullest extent permitted by law HRNZ will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss) or for personal injury as a result of Promotion entry or winning the Prize. Where the Prize is to be supplied by an entity outside HRNZ control and that entity fails, for whatever reason, to supply the Prize, HRNZ has no responsibility for the provision of the Prize and is not obliged to provide an alternative Prize or to take legal action to require the Prize supplier to provide the Prize. HRNZ reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who HRNZ has reason to believe has breached any of these Ts and Cs or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Promotion.
