

## 27 July 2021

On Tuesday July 20, 2021, the HRNZ board approved the following changes to the Handicapping Ratings system:

Action	Action	Date effective
Maiden winner	That when a horse assessed as a maiden, wins its first race, its rating will move from MR to R for the level it was on e.g., MR50 will move to R50, MR46 to R46. Effectively the horse will start in the Ratings system at its current level.	Immediately
Race Winners Matrix	The race winner's matrix to reflect the value of the stakes the horse is racing for. <u>Refer attached matrix.</u>	2 August 2021
5 <sup>th</sup> placing	Create larger differential between 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> and the also ran stake. 5 <sup>th</sup> placing is now an also ran stake and attracts a -1 point in the handicapping ratings system. The also ran percentage will reduce from 2% to 1.75%. For clarification refer to examples of stakes attached. Group and listed races remain unchanged except the also ran percentage will change from 2% to 1.75%.	2 August 2021
2YO and 3YO concessions	2YO and 3YO horses maintain their current concessions throughout the transition period (1 August – 31 December). The ratings caps will be removed for the transition period with the Handicapper given the ability to re-rate horses on 1 January 2022, that have been disaffected by the removal of the rating caps or that have climbed to an artificially inflated rating for performing in age group races.	2 August 2021
	There will be additional 2YO and 3YO races programmed over the transition period to encourage this age group to race in their age groups. <u>Refer</u>	

	attached transition programme. Please note that these races will be programmed only if there are enough nominations. The 2YO and 3YO concessions are being reviewed as part of the change of birthday and any change to these for a new racing calendar of January 1 thru December 31. Any changes will be decided by the Board at the November meeting.	If changes then effective January 1, 2022
Penalty free race per season	Horses 4YO and older, up to rating 70, will be entitled to one free penalty free win per racing calendar year rather than per lifetime. This is to align with the change of horse's birthday.	January 1, 2022
Junior Concessions	Junior concessions are to be introduced for junior drivers to encourage owners/trainers to give juniors more opportunity. The concessions will be based on levels according to the number of wins a junior has driven. It will be possible for a junior to outdrive their claim. Research is being done on options: dropping a grade by the number of points; or only earning a reduced number of points. These will be considered at the November Board meeting for implementation for the new racing calendar year.	January1, 2021
