


Horse **Ambulance**

2022/23 Horse Care & Welfare Spend


What we achieved:

- Introduced the Horse Care Regulations.

- Decrease in the number of fatal race day injuries with the help of the Horse Ambulance and consistently good tracks to race on.
- Trainer stable audits have commenced by the RIB to assess compliance with the Horse Care Regulations.
- The MyHRNZ app now has many extra features to make processes for trainers and owners
- HRNZ developed Life After Racing funding grants that are available to rehomers.
