HRNZ - NATIONAL FORUM - March 2024

The National Forum Report, held via Zoom on 25th March 2024, covered several key updates and discussions:

- Tri-code Negotiations: Currently at an impasse and moving to mediation.
 Mediators need to be appointed.
- 2. **Tri-code Dates Agreement**: Progressing with representatives M Barsi and J Mooney.
- 3. **Updated Constitution**: Being worked on to comply with the new Incorporated Societies Act 2022, leading to a future SGM.
- 4. Board Charter: Being updated using Boardworks.
- 5. Forbury Park: Initial submission made, sale proceeds held in a Trust Fund.
- 6. Audit and Risk Committee: Busy with various tasks.
- 7. **CEO Recruitment**: Over 30 applications received, closing on 1st April. Selection panel includes Richard Stenhouse, John Hartnell, Phil Holden, and Cam Bray, with Alan Isaac later agreed as the fourth member.
- 8. **Racing Dates**: Need to meet Entain's aspirations, potential funding shortfall risk for next season.
- 9. Venue Reviews: Currently "parked" by the Board.
- 10. **HRNZ Communications**: Considered average, with plans for regular updates and potential podcasts.
- 11. **IAP (New Board)**: Requirements being collated and actioned, with Alan Isaacs as IAP Chair.
- 12. **Code of Conduct**: To manage unacceptable behaviour.
- 13. **Promotion Funding**: Discussed appropriate use, work in progress with Entain.
- 14. **Promotion of Forums**: Discussed achieving better penetration.

Additional discussions included the CEO appointment, the importance of a skills matrix for the new Board, and the proposal of approximately 30 new racing dates next season. The dearth of Fillies & Mares races was also noted. The meeting closed at approximately 3 pm.
